

Aameen.</p> <p>Here is an overview of what we will be studying in the autumn term. IA</p>	
<p>English This term we will be analysing and writing fictional stories, biographies, autobiographies, reports and newspaper articles. We will also be looking at personification in poetry and reading works of established authors, discussing styles and themes. We will be constructing more complex sentences using prepositions, active and passive forms and various connectives. Additionally, we will recap and reinforce the use of punctuation.</p> 	<p>Maths-topics that will be studied are: Place value, prime numbers, square numbers, ordering and rounding, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division of whole numbers and decimals. Fractions, percentages, ratio and proportion; 2D and 3D shapes and their properties; reflections and translations.</p> 
<p>Science This term we will be looking at the units 'Classifying Organisms' and 'Evolution and Inheritance'. The latter topic will be explored from an Islamic perspective.</p> 	<p>Geography Children will be investigating through research, places in the UK, Europe and further afield that share similar physical environments, specifically mountains.</p> 
<p>DT/Art Students will be investigating 'Shelters', a step by step approach to how shelters are made, and then they will be creating their own little shelter using a range of materials.</p> 	<p>History We will be studying World War 2, the events leading up to the war and what happened after the war ended.</p> 
<p>PE We will be playing batting and fielding games such as cricket and rounders including the skills required for each.</p> 	<p>ICT/Computing This term we will be learning how to create PowerPoint presentations and simple spreadsheets using Microsoft Excel.</p> 
<p>Religious Education/Languages Ilm-at-tawheed Mother and daughters of our Prophet (saw) Arabic language – weather and seasons</p> <p>العربية</p>	<p>Citizenship/PSHE "How rules and laws affect me". Children will discuss the need of for societies to run smoothly and rules safely.</p>
